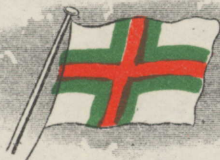

25 cases No. 1 Sugar.



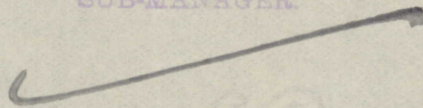
