No-10 & 11 Repairing 4. Rafter. and Ridge Board. where carried away, relaying roof. where broken. and pointing same where necessary. Taking out and replacing Becks. where damaged in several places. and pointing front. where necessary.

Taking down front. Gutters. and replacing same with new G. as before. On no. (12 & 13) repointing and replacing all slates. where holed with rifle. holes. and fixing part. of gutter where broken with new if necessary. Kitchens of no 10 & 11

repairing roofs of same. where Ruberoid torn by splinters of shell etc. making good all damages. for the sum of Thirty Pounds (£ 30 =). Accepting all risks and furnishing all materials.
