"Nothing was said to me about damage, although I saw the owner every day. One officer's charger and 6 pack ponies were billeted in these premises, and the pack animals were only there for one week, so it is inconceivable that damage to the extent of £4. could be done in the time, and be unnoticed by me when going round each day. No vehicle ever entered the yard so that it is difficult to see how the gate could have been damaged."
