I had an interview with claimants father this evening! This Son is employed in the Fost Office as a Telegraph Boy. On. Interests in the buildings. Easter monday he eyeled to business at the S. F. O. and machine was put in the bicycle shed. a little after twelve o'clock he was ordered by the rebels to leave the penises, but was not allowed to take the machine and it is believed that it was subsequently destroyed in the fire. It is a second hand markine and was bought about 18 months ago at. an auction for £4. The claimant is 14 to years of age, and has been at business for last twelve months. He had nothing to do with the rebellion.
