

Referring to our telephone communication yesterday we beg to inform you that the premises 13 Serpentine Avenue were leased by John Pearson who was then the owner of the Fearson Estate (to Robert Buchanan and Mrs. Susan Abbott under a lease dated the 12th June 1847 for a term of 66 years from the 24th December 1847 and this lease expired on December 1913 and was not renewed.

The policy for fire insurance was taken out by members of the Buchanan family who were entitled to the lessees interest in the lease referred to. Our client Miss Cree was in communication with Mrs. Buchanan who stated that she was acting as agent for the present owners and the lessees interest and who apparently resided in America and she gave Miss Cree the name and address of the person to whom she sent the rent out of 13 Serpentine Avenue and Miss Cree heard from him stating that he did not make any claim in respect of the premises and that no steps were going to be taken to get a renewal of this lease.
