## Claim for Damages caused during the Disturbances on the 24th April, 1916, and following days.

I Anne Hoey now residing  
at 45 Lower Leeson Street in the City of Dublin widow  
do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April  
1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely:—twenty bags of  
Sugar then in the warehouse of Tedcastle McFormick & Co. Limited,  
at Sir John Rogerson's Quay, in the said City of Dublin,  
and such damage was occasioned to the best of my belief by \*\*looting consequent
