1st July 1916.

Sir - I beg to state with reference to my application of 22nd May 1916 for £1-10-0 Compensation for damage to a Table, and Couch; used as a Barricade on the Streets to shield the Soldiers from the Rebels. I have since got these articles of furniture, repaired at Small Cast. I now respectfully withdraw my Claim for above amount.

The dislocation of my house for two days, by the occupation of the Soldiers for two days, was my greatest grievance.
