We duly received your letter of 10th inst. (unsigned) with reference to our claim, informing us that as the losses sustained are in the nature of consequential damages your Committee are precluded by the terms of the reference from considering the claim." This view of our claim surprises us and we regret we must resist it as we are quite unable to see in what respect our claim can be distinguished from other claims of property owners whose property was damaged or destroyed as a direct result of the Rebellion and whose claims have been admitted. We beg to ask, therefore, that your Committee will take our claim into consideration as one which properly falls within the ambit of their terms of reference.
