We beg to inform you that our Printing and Bookbinding Factory at 61 & 62 Great Strand Street was during the recent conflict occupied by a body of troops and that they removed from the premises a quantity of Printing Paper, and sheets of books ready printed for publication.

Some of the paper had been used in the construction of barricades in Great Strand Street, and this we recovered on the resumption of business, but a quantity is missing, of the value specified in the enclosed memorandum. We also submit an estimate of the cost of repairs to our premises, the doors and windows having been seriously injured.

We beg to apply to you to have our losses considered in connection with any action which the Government may take on the general question of compensation.
