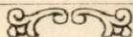

I James B. Curran now residing

at 82 Ballybough Road in the City of Dublin County of Dublin

do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 29th day of April

1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely:— ** the entire contents with the exception of three casks of whiskey of my shop, which at 82 Ballybough Road, City of Dublin, were taken away, stolen or destroyed and the glass in the lower portion of my card shop and premises was also destroyed & fixtures fittings & doors were injured* and such damage was occasioned to the best of ^{my} ~~our~~ belief by *** a number of persons breaking into my said premises none of whom deponent knows*
