Referring to my claim (no 3300) amounting

to £465-17-10 against which I received a payment
of £910.

may I respectfully remark that I hardly consider this
sum adequate in view of the fact that in making out the
claim I made my statement of etc with absolute fairness
and ignored all matters tending towards consequential losses,
also ignoring the losses I suffered from being unable to
recover book and cash debts vouchers for which I possessed
previews to my premises being destroyed the latter item alone
would at least be £150 even after making allowance for
possible subsequent payments to me.

may I therefore ask you if you will kindly again bring
this matter before your committee for their further attention,
feeling sure that when all things are considered they will come to
the conclusion that — as I have already remarked — the payment I
have received is not as sufficient as the fairness
of the claim would entitle me to expect.




