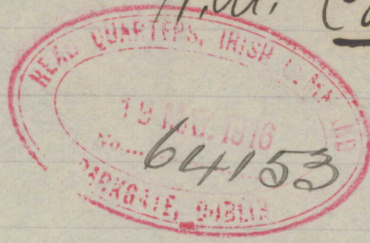

During recent Riots in Dublin a house of mine, 33 Mallybough Road Dublin, which was vacant awaiting arrival of incoming tenant was taken over by Military, and a party of South Stafford Regiment remained there from the 5th to the 12th inst both days inclusive, and troops caused damage which required me to expend £2.5.0 to make good & since I am out of rent for said time which is £32 yearly, plus Rate & Taxes, I respectfully beg to claim me all but £3.0.0 Actual Cost which amount I am at a loss

I attach a Bill for repairs only from my Man, Hoping to receive a favourable reply
