Carried on business as physical culturist and boxing instructor at Lr.Bridge Street, Dublin.

Raid by military on the 5th May in search for arms - none found and claimant had nothing whatever to do with the rising. The military broke up boxing stage value £6, his pictures, goods &c. were all damaged by fire from Doherty's hotel adjoining on the 28th April.
