I am instructed by the Executors of Cecilia Maria Shannon, deceased, proprietors under Fee Farm Grant, of the premises, 37 Henry Street, to institute a claim for compensation by reason of the total destruction of their premises during the recent insurrection movement in Dublin.

I am advised that the destruction of the house was caused by the Military operations, and am therefore of opinion that a claim cannot be made for criminal injury under the Local Government Board (Ireland) 1888, against the rates

of the City.
