Dear Sir

I shall be much obliged if you will kindly place before your committee the following statement of my very pressing position.

Before the destruction of my business I had two good paying branches (1). My own original business as Advertising Artist which had been built up by me after many years of industry and hard work. I had in hand as my claim shows machinery and effects fittings papers (a stock of which is now unpurchasable) advertising effects of the total value £548.18.0

I had also paid the last instalment for the purchase of the Reliance Advertising Co. (which I run as a separate undertaking). I had stationery and printing matter value £300, as per claim of Reliance Advertising Co.

I have had to incur an expenditure of £130 in order to purchase paper and machinery inks, to re-start my business, the want of which has crippled me considerably and I have to pay cash down for stock to carry on my artist contracts. I am now greatly jeopardised and unable to carry on not having any money in hand. I have had very severe times since the Insurrection and have been daily hoping that my case will be dealt with. It is now of the most urgent importance to me to have the matter gone into as early as you.

Under these circumstances I shall be glad if your Committee would authorise a payment on account of the sum of £120. So as to avoid my complete ruination.
