Mary Reynolds

Not proceeded with (hist 94)

Claim of Mary Reynolds. 115 Foley Street. Widow.

Mrs Reynolds resided for four years, two top rooms No.79 Lr. Gardiner Street with her daughter.

On Easter Wednesday soldiers broke in hall door and came into Mrs. Reynolds room. They smashed all her pictures including including photo of son in Royal Irish Rifles, at present "somewhere in France". She also states they fired shots and smashed ceiling, delph and so forth for no apparent reason.
