

The building in this case was practically gutted by fire. Claimant was lodging at this address at the time of the outbreak, and most of her Wearing Apparel, &c. was lost. I have gone into each item fully and consider that sufficient allowance was not made for depreciation in various articles. I think £18. would be about the limit of her loss.
