I have carefully investigated this claim. I have been through the premises with the Claimant. The Policy on glass has no Riot Clause and Interests in the buildings

the Liverpool & London & Globe Insurance Company must therefore pay.

As regards the claim for £5.10. 0., claimant informs me that he was out of pocket to this amount in one way or another to employees of Neary's Public House and others who barricaded the premises subsequent to the glass being broken, and in this way saved a considerable amount of stock from the looters. There is no liability for this under an insurance policy but Companies invariably reward such work. I think, however, a sum of £4. would be considered ample. The item would not come under the heading of consequential loss. I recommend that the sum of £4. be granted over and above my valuation.
