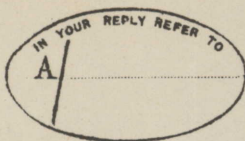

Sir,

We are Solicitors for Messrs John Wallis & Sons, Railway Agents of 33 Bachelor's Walk in this City, and are instructed by our clients to bring under your notice the following facts :-

On the 27th April last three officers and thirty men belonging to the 6th North Staffordshire, 6th Lincoln's & Sherwood Forester Regiments occupied our clients premises on Bachelor's Walk for Military purposes, and remained in possession thereof until the 3rd May inst - During the period of occupation by the Military, our clients and their staff remained out of the premises at the request of the officer in charge -, and on our clients resuming possession on the 3rd inst, they found that considerable damage was caused to the exterior and interior of the premises - they instructed a Firm of Contractors to examine the premises, who have reported that it will cost a sum of £107:4:10 to make good the damage. In addition, damage was done to the

private property of our clients staff amounting to £5:16:0

We shall thank you to bring this claim under the notice of the Authorities, whom we are sure will not hesitate to compensate our clients and their staff for the damage done -
