five shillings (£2. 5. 0) damages.

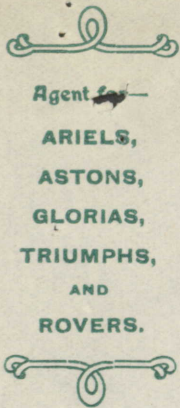
