I am instructed by Mr. Lyons of 11, Upper Island to apply to the Military Authorities for compensation in respect of damage done to the premises during the recent rebellion. The house was occupied by the Dublin Fusiliers on the Thursday of Easter Week and my client and his family had to leave. On their return my client found that the panels in a number of doors had been broken, also a looking glass and several panes of glass. In addition the roof was shelled by gun fire, the front of the house perforated with bullet holes, including the hall door, the yard gate broken down, also two other doors in yard and practically
