Interests in the buildings

The clothes and boots (items 1/2 of claim) were in use for some twelve months and were purchased at Hyam's - not likely to have cost £3. 15. 0. and 14/6 respectively. The bracelet was a present from Claimant's married daughter and the gold watch and chain were the property of her first husband. I am inclined to be sceptical as to whether these gold articles were in the house at the time of the looting in view of Claimant's statement that the money - £3. also claimed for was borrowed two days previously from a Jew. If Claimant receives £7 compensation I think she will have been fairly dealt with. House had to be vacated by order of military. Rented at 8/- per week.
