We beg to inform you that a quantity of Flour, the property of Messrs Thomas Rigby & Sons Ltd. of Waterloo Dock Mills, Liverpool, was looted from the stores of Messrs Tedeastle McCormick & Co.Ltd. during the recent disturbances. Messrs Rigby have sustained a loss of £218. 16. 0 and we are instructed to claim compensation for same against your Government. We will thank you to note this claim with reference to any scheme for compensation that may be introduced.
