
Sir,

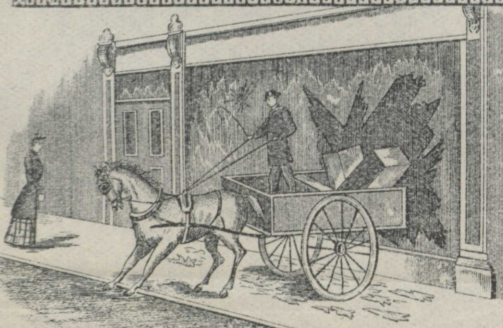

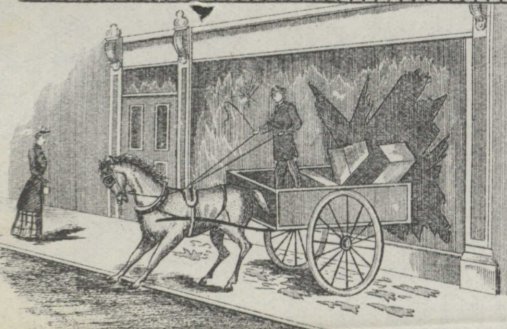
