Interests in the buildings Claimant is bound, under the terms of her lease, to maintain the Building in thorough repair. The Building damage consists of the repairs to wooden side door leading from Hall into Shop, and a broken pane of glass in Shop front. No liability attaches in respect of the latter. See Hebronian Glass Co's Policy No. 4130, and renewal notice for mid summer 1915 attached.

I experienced considerable difficulty in arriving at a true approximation of the loss sustained under the head of "Goods Looted", owing to the intervention of an independent Fire Assessor employed by the claimant, and who in his original list of goods missing made a error of some £15.15 in the estimation of his figures under the 2<sup>nd</sup> item - see also List attached. However, I did not take advantage of this slip in arriving at an approximation of the Loss which I consider should be assessed at £42.1.2.


