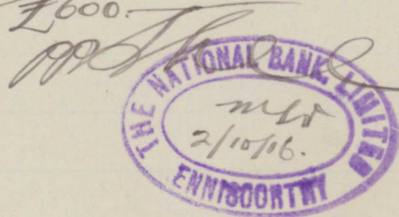

Claim for Damages caused during the Disturbances on the 24th April, 1916, and following days.

We Thomas Duff & Edward Duff trading as Duff Bros. now residing at Slaney Street, Eumiscorthy, in the County of Wexford do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 28th day of April 1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely:—* Goods and Provisions
