In reply to your favor of 9th inst., the £12. represents (so far as I was able to ascertain) Mr Doyle's own personal loss directly due to the Rebellion.

With reference to the work done for Mrs Wyse-Power, I took the view that she was responsible to Mr ~~XXXX~~ Doyle for payment of his Account, and that the proper course to be pursued was for Mrs Wyse-Power to include the item in her claim. Apart from the foregoing, as I had not the assessing of Mrs Wyse-Power's claim, there was a possibility of "overlapping" which I wished to avoid.

The circumstances were very fully explained to Mr Doyle, who accepted my view, and who was to get into immediate touch with Mrs Wyse-Power in the matter.
