Referring to this case the papers in connection with which were returned to you on the 19<sup>th</sup> inst. I have given the matter of the claim for glass further consideration. - Claimants hold a policy for glass breakage with the Liverpool Victoria Legal Society covering all risks but some little time ago this Society was merged in the Commercial Union Co which company when receiving the renewal premium this year placed an endorsement on the renewal receipt including riot & civil commotion risks. -

I am strongly of the opinion that an endorsement is not binding unless it is placed on the policy & I have come to the conclusion that the Commercial Union Company are therefore liable to replace the glass. - I shall be obliged if you will attach this to my report & reduce the claim to £25. 10.0 for stock only. - No doubt if you wrote the Commercial Union Co. on the matter, it would have the desired effect.

On the 26th of April ult., about 1 o'clock p.m. Messrs. Anderson Stanford & Ridgeway's premises, 28 Grafton Street, were fired into and a good deal of glass was broken, and some carpets which were in the window were permanently damaged. It would appear that the shots were fired by the troops in Trinity College for the purpose of keeping away looters from Messrs. Knowles' premises. The total damage amounts to £82. 14. 4.

Under the circumstances we shall be glad to know if the Military Authorities are prepared to accept liability for the damage so committed.
