Two front doors broken open beyond repair, and the pannels of two interior doors smashed. Two locked desks broken open, Claim 210, (and sundry other breakages.)

We enclose a list of damage incurred by the soldiers removing the furniture etc., from our Gatekeeper's house, (219, 0, 6,) to make barricades.
