



ESTIMATE and Specification for Sundry works to be done at and to the house 25 Bishop Street for Mr. James Kelly as follows: -

Sundry Works inside of House

To glaze the sundry panes of glass broken in room windows viz: - 13

Panes 26 oz. glass, and have the necessary locks and keys to doors of rooms made good where injured, sundry repairs done to doors and door casings, windows - timber work of same and hanging and supplying sash cords to sashes where broken, necessary plumbing repairs done to Whiskey casks in Store room where injured and necessary shelves where removed from walls, repairs to brick walls on Staircase and in top front room and plastering same sundry necessary carpentry repairs done to balusters handrail and newd post, sheeting and shelves in Hall, necessary repairs done in cellar and to door in yard, necessary repairs done to Entrance Halldoor, new Chubbs' lock and fitments to same, glazing plateglass in entrance door of Shop, also windows and repairs to Venetian blind where broken, having the necessary repairs done to slating on roof of house where injured, brickwork on front of house and repairs to stone sill .

The above works done in a proper workmanlike manner including all materials.
