As requested I have visited the above building and examined the stonework of parapets to main flat roof.

There are two 8' 0" Bays in front to Lewis Street, and one 6' 0" to North end, damaged by Gunfire. The parapet consists of a stone base 2' 0" x 1' 2" deeply chamfered on both sides - a panel over same 8" thick, and 1' 11" high, perforated and chamfered etc, and a coping 11" x 5", weathered, & molded.

All the above work is in Limestone. There is damage to brickwork of some of the piers at above bays. The cost of removing the coping, and panel stones of the above three bays, and replacing same with new stonework, & including the repairing of brickwork and all necessary scaffolding, & tackle, and lowering and removing the old stone I estimate to be Eightyone Pound two shillings £81. 2. 0.

The three heavy stone bases are bullet-marked - I have not taken any repairs to them.
