



We are in receipt of your favour of \$1st May, and respectfully desire to inform you that the Government have agreed to treat looted goods as if they had been insured, and to compensate the owners for same. It has not yet been decided how, or by whom such claims shall be rendered to the Government, but when an arrangement has been made, we shall be glad to lend you every assistance.

The question of our liability does not arise, as, by our Conditions of Carriage we are fully protected.
