Sir,

On behalf of Mr T.W. Bowles, Marriage Registrar's Office, Wellington Quay, I have to present a claim for compensation for damage to his furniture and premises during the recent Insurrection .

Mr Bowles invited the Military into his premises which occupied a position commanding some roofs on the opposite side of the Quay from which the Rebels were firing and from Mr Bowles premises the Military silenced their fire. The Military Fire from Mr Bowles premises was replied to, with the result that damage was done to the premises; two sheets of plate glass were broken, walls were injured, a door and curtain, a bullet passed through the Piano and some other damage was also occasioned

We would suggest that a sum of £25 should be paid to Mr Bowles in settlement of this claim.

We may mention that Mr Bowles gave every assistance to the Military and some of the men were wounded in his

premises

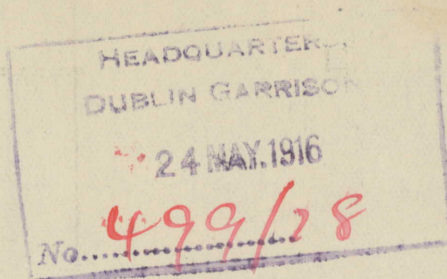
