
Inspector's Subsequent Report.

I called at 33 Lower Bridge St., Dublin, and found it an Eating House of a very poor description managed by Alfred Bucke who informed me that Kenny's wife called there for letters, he (Kenny) being in South Dublin Union. I therefore visited South Dublin Union and found after a good deal of trouble that Kenny entered there on 19th May and left on 19th July, leaving no address to which I could trace him. I therefore Alfred Bucke further. After much inquiry
I believe 30/- a modest claim for the grinding
machine which was undoubtedly lost. Kenny is
said by Union authorities to be of good
character, aged 60 years.

If payment be made, care will require to be
taken that the money finds its way to the
Claimant. Bridge Street is a very poor quarter
