Sir,

I formally claim the sum of £120. 11. 3 in respect of property looted and destroyed or damaged during the recent disturbances in Dublin. All this property was in my rooms at the City Hall, Dublin, of which I am the housekeeper and from which I was expelled by the rebels on their entering same on East Monday last.

When I was next permitted to enter the City Hall it was in the occupation of the military and on examining my rooms I found that same had been looted and pillaged and most of the property had been carried off or destroyed or damaged so far as to be absolutely unfit for further use.
