Interests in the buildings

This building was at rear of Metropole Hotel and was used as bar on the first and second floors, with a room on ground floor let at 15/- per quarter as Club Room to the Society. A leather bag containing the books, stationery and such like was enclosed in an oak chest padlocked, such chest also containing the banner. There is apparently nobody now in the Society who recollects the purchasing of the banner which is stated to be some 50 years old. It is an oil painted banner on canvas, trimmed with gold lace, with fittings for securing same on to the back of a car. The price claimed is ridiculous, and is, the Secretary advises me, put down at random. £25. should be ample to compensate.
