Interests in the buildings I had an interview with the Applicant in this connection, who is most respectable. The Machine was burnt in the conflagration in Sackville Street during Easter week and was 8 months in use. The Bicycle was purchased from Kelly of Lower Abbey Street for the amount stated, and this I verified. I also obtained verification from the Claimant's employer. I find, however, that no allowance has been made for the period the Machine was in use, and though I am informed that same had been little used, I am quite satisfied that the sum of £7.10.0 will be very acceptable to the Claimant.
