

On 26th April 1916 she had to vacate the premises by order of the military authorities, taking as much of her stock as she possibly could. The Table claimed for contained patterns - not of the usual type, but really samples of military hats. The trimmings included chin straps. The claimant works on orders for Military Taps for Messrs. Johnston's, Seale's, Clery's, Todd's, &c.

The Watch (1b/-) and Blouse Material (5/-) were the property of Claimant's sister Elizabeth


