The Military during the recent disturbances between April 24th and 1st of May last, entered a house the property of a Client of ours Mrs. Florence E. C. Gibson at 34, Lr. Mount Stl, in this City and in getting on the roof apparently in discharge of Military operations damaged it and a press cupboard under dormer and shelving, removed the plaster checks of Dormer windows and sash and glass of windows of Top back bedroom were broken, the damage being estimated at £3 by a Contractor and we have to ask you to forward a claim for that amount to the Secretary of the Treasury or other the proper quarter.
