Rebellion, and although not expecting the
full amount, £ 59. 10. 0 is not a very adequate
proportion for the loss sustained.

My works consisted of a bust of George Russell
(R) a little larger than life which took more
than three months to carve (It is much clearer the bronze)
for which I asked £ 105. 0. 0 a very reasonable
amount.

A Tented Statuette priced at the low figure of 20.
0. 0 with the object of inducing some member of the
Dublin Public to buy it. And Three pedestals at
£ 3. 10 of which one alone cost me £ 2. 5. 0

I think you will agree that £ 59. 10. 0 is
not a fair proportion of the amount asked
& hope that this will receive your further
consideration.
