

This unfortunate man was at the time of the rising residing with his wife and small family at Henry Place. The heavy furniture Interests in the buildings

was requisitioned by the Military for the purpose of forming barricades near the G.P.O. and the balance of his furniture and effects were entirely consumed in the subsequent conflagration. To add to his troubles one of his children accidentally got shot dead.

I have most carefully investigated this claim and have confidence in recommending that my valuation be adopted.
