

Twas informed to day that the Military Outhorities are paying claims for wilful damage done by soldiers. Thence report that on Wedy in Rebellin week the caretaker opened the hall door of this building to a company of soldiers who denied the search it. My office door was locked and the caretaker had nother. The lock was therefore burst open othe place searched. This I presume was institable. I had however just purchased ille of tolacco which cost me 5 3. This wastaken away by the soldiers and I consider I should

be paid if any ouch claims are entertained. The hall down was locked after the departure of the soldiers o no one else was in the building until it was not ne opened by me. The emptied tin lies here still as left- by the military. Several locus in my pivalé house have been boten at what cost to repair I do not yet. Know may I ask if this expense will be refunded. The statement was freely made at the time of search that such unted be paid, by the non. Coms in charge. I attached very little improstance to their assurances, but on second tunglis desire to asse ficially - Joursfeithfully James O'Herre
