

RECEIVED from ALFRED W. HARRIS, J. P. the sum of fourteen pounds ten shillings for work done in pulling down the walls and ruins of two five story houses 67 76% 37 and 38 Middle Abbey Street by order of the Corporation. Mr Harris as Landlord immediately above the occupiers being legally liable. The Corporation ordered the work to be carried out forthwith "as being dangerous and threatening the public safety."

The houses were destroyed by the bombardment of the Military on or about the 24th April, 1916.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Ruins of the house 64 kneddle abbey Strut

Ms in a dangerous state, and threatens the public safety, and I now hereby require you, as the Owner or Occupier of such premises, forthwith to take down, secure, or repair the same; and if within seven days next after the posting, or the service on you of this Notice, you fail to comply with the requisitions aforesaid, I hereby apprize you that I shall make complaint thereof before the Divisional Justice or Justices, with a view to his or their ordering you so to take down, repair or otherwise secure the same to my satisfaction, within a time to be fixed by said Justice or Justices. And on your failing to comply with such order, I further apprize you that the Lord Mayor of the City or Borough shall then proceed, with all convenient speed, to have such dangerous structure, or so much thereof as may be necessary, taken down, or otherwise secured in such manner as shall be requisite, in which event all the expenses incident thereto, and to the shoring up, boarding up, watching and lighting of such dangerous structure must be paid by you as such Owner or Occupier, pursuant to the provisions of the statute in such case made and provided.
