and such damage was occasioned to the best of ~~our~~ <sup>my</sup> belief by fire during the Rebellion

And ~~we~~ <sup>I</sup> further declare that the Property and Articles specified on the other side were so destroyed or damaged; that the Cost Price of same was as shown in each case; that at the time of the destruction or damage they were respectively of the Values specified under the head "Value of Property at time of Destruction or Damage"; and that, in consequence of such destruction or damage, claim is hereby made for the sums specified under the head "Amount Claimed"; that the Claim is made by me
