Dear Sir

With reference to the destruction by fire of the G. P. O. in connection with the recent rebellion I beg to state that on Easter Monday I attended for duty in the Instrument Room at 12 noon. I left my bicycle in the basement of the G. P. O. prior to taking up duty and I was with others summarily ejected from the G. P. O. premises shortly before one o'clock. I was not allowed to obtain my bicycle before leaving and it was destroyed in the fire. I beg to ask that I be recouped for the loss of the machine. It originally cost 12 guineas but as it had been in use for several years a fair present value would be £3. I have since had to purchase a second hand machine at a cost of five pounds (£5)
