Dear Sir,

I am instructed by Mr. Joseph A. Clarke of 61 Bolton Street, Dublin to present a claim for £9-0-0 to the Military Authorities for damage done to his premises 61 Bolton Street by rifle and machinegun fire during the recent disturbances in the city. The damage is to a chimney stack, a sky-light, and the roof of the house.

I understand that somtime ago when the Police called to Mr. Clarke he informed them that no damage had been done to the premises. But the chimney stack and sky-light damaged are only visible from the roof, and so at the time he was not aware of their state.
