We are in receipt of your favour of yesterday, with regard to the short delivery of 3 cases Sultanas, value £6. 13. 6 and now desire to inform you these were looted from our stores during the recent disturbance.

As you are no doubt aware, the Government have agreed to treat all looted goods as if they had been insured, and to compensate the owners for same. It has not yet been decided whether such claims will be rendered to the Government by individual firms, or whether the carrying Companies will be asked to do so, but in the meantime we would suggest that you submit your demand to.
