I have been directed that you are open to receive and compensate all injury done to the property of unoffending citizens by the troops under your Command. As you are aware that for the first few days of the Rebellion the 10th Battalion of the Dublin Fusiliers were stationed in and about the Mendicity Institution situate at 9 and 10 Ushers's Island. My property was damaged by their rifle fire to the rough extent of £2 not including minor damages, although your troops were not hindered or molested in the execution of their duty by myself or any inmate of my house.

At your early convenience I shall be glad to hear from you.
