

The building is situate opposite the Ballsbridge Show Grounds, the ground floor being used as the Pembroke Dispensary, the upper portion being occupied by Claimants as dwellinghouse. The building seems to have been badly damaged. The items of claim are somewhat excessive. The Piano is an antiquated, small cottage type, and would not be likely to fetch much by auction. I would put its full value at £2. Claimants ought to be reasonably compensated by the payment of £13.
