

The following articles were taken from my house at above address during the time my family and self were sheltering in the Custom house from the recent trouble.

One D. B. I2 bore C. F. shot gun in mahogany case with accessories One D. B. I2 bore Pin fire shot gun.

One cartridge belt containing 25,12 bore shot cartridges. I2 bore ammunition to the extent of about 100 carteidges.

As I at present hold a license to have and use a gun and also held a peace preservation license in the days when the City and County were proclamined, I wish to enquire if the government will be kind enough to return these articles? Apologising for tresspassing on your valuable time and trusting to be favoured with a satisfactory reply;
